# Make Your Own Đominoes 

## Equipment:

3 sheets A4 Card or large piece of Cardboard
Pencil \& Pens
Scissors
Ruler

## How to make:

- You need 28 domino tiles to make a set.
- Using a pencil and ruler divide an A4 sheet of card in half lengthways so you have two columns.
- Divide the page equally so you have 5 rows so you end up with the outline of 10 domino tile
 domino tiles so you have 2 extra/spare).
- Divide each column in half so you end up with 4 columns (if you want, you can do this in a different colour so you remember not to cut along these lines)
- Do the same on 2 more sheets of A4 (you end up with 30
- Design the dominoes to suit what you want (E.g. times tables, numbers, fractions, phonics, theme etc.), follow the template below if you want to use them to play the traditional domino game. Alternatively if they are for making a domino train, follow the second template.
- Cut the pieces out and you're ready to play. (If you want card pieces to last longer you can laminate them first before cutting them out)
